According to Director of Tax Services, Justin Gordon the total 2020 Property Tax Roll is \$268,251,520.95. Historically, 80% of the total tax roll is collected in November, equaling nearly \$214 million dollars should that trend continue. Gordon adds, "The Tax Collector office mailed 120,700 bills, including notices for tangible personal property on October 30, 2020.
