Covid-19 may have postponed our fall program, but we're ready to go for a spring run in time for a <u>Mother's Day</u> delivery! For those who don't know, Kids Tag Art is a program where, to date, over 5000 unique designs have been created locally, and thousands of dollars have been raised for participating schools here in Okaloosa County! As a fundraiser for your school and an art contest for your students, Kids Tag Art has proven to be very successful in Okaloosa County. During the past seven years this project has garnered over \$83,000.00 for local elementary schools! These are <u>non-budgeted funds</u> to support and embrace the Arts or secondary projects at your school.

The Okaloosa County Tax Collector's Office issues many different types of "specialty" or "vanity" license tags for registered automobiles. Some specialty tags support charitable organizations and a portion of the purchase price goes to support that organization. With that in mind, we are offering the Kids Tag Art program to the Okaloosa School District as a way to support the Arts in our local schools. We hope you will participate with us this school year.

Kids Tag Art encourages students to design their own license plate art and, for approximately \$15.00, it can be printed as their <u>own unique specialty tag</u>. These make great special occasion gifts and keepsakes as well. Each school earns 100% of the net proceeds (less printing costs) from the sale of their students' tags. The sale of these tags means additional dollars for your class, through class-room sales, contests, awards and <u>simply just for participating!</u>
